2. INPUT STANDARDS

2.1. Suitable majors without additional knowledge: Law group

2.2. Suitable majors for additional knowledge

Graduates from the University of Procuracy; Academy of Courts, National Academy of Administration; graduates from law-related training majors at universities of the Police and Army.

2.3. General requirements:

- Graduated or qualified for recognition of university graduation (or equivalent level or higher) in a suitable field. For candidates who graduated from majors that require additional knowledge, candidates must have a decision to recognize the results of additional knowledge.

- Have foreign language proficiency level B1 (level 3/6) according to the 6-level foreign language proficiency framework for Vietnam or have a diploma or certificate equivalent to level 3/6 according to regulations of the Ministry of Education and Training. Candidates who do not meet the entrance foreign language proficiency must register for the entrance foreign language proficiency test according to regulations.

- Candidates who are foreign citizens, if applying to study master's programs in Vietnamese, must have Vietnamese proficiency at Level 4 or higher according to the Vietnamese Proficiency Framework for Foreigners or have graduated from university (or equivalent level or higher) where the training program is taught in Vietnamese; meet the second foreign language requirements as prescribed by the training institution (if any).

3. TRAINING OBJECTIVES

3.1. General objectives

The Master of Business Law (applied orientation) training program of Nam Can Tho University aims to train students to master in-depth theoretical knowledge of the Economic Law system, thereby students are able to skillfully apply knowledge of Economic Law to solve complex legal problems related to the legal field; have the ability to self-study, work independently and creatively, have legal practice skills to meet the requirements of the labor market in the context of the 4.0 technology revolution.

3.2. Specific objectives

The Master of Business Law training program aims at the following specific objectives:

M1: Equip learners with in-depth specialized knowledge in the field of economic law and related knowledge.

M2: Train learners to have legal practice skills, and the ability to apply law to solve complex legal problems related to the field of economic law.

M3: Train learners to have the ability to work independently, creatively, and have the ability to detect and solve problems; have the ability to self-study and self-study throughout life.

M4: Training learners to be loyal to the Fatherland, conscious of obeying the law, socially responsible; have a spirit of serving the community , and have good professional ethics.

10. Evaluation of professional internship results

10.1 Learners who have accumulated at least 30 credits of the master's training program (application orientation) can register for a professional internship outside the training institution. Students contact the internship location appropriate to their training major. The school supports students with administrative procedures to contact the internship location. Internship is considered a mandatory component of the master's training program (application orientation) .

10.2. Assessment of the professional internship portion of the course is carried out through the form of marking the internship diary to assess the attendance score (weighted at 30%); marking and presenting the internship report to assess the professional results in the student's internship activities (weighted at 70%). Assessment of the student's internship results on professional content is carried out by the specialized faculty.

11. Graduation project evaluation

Graduation project evaluation is conducted by the Graduation Project Evaluation Council established by the school according to current master's training and admission regulations.

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
