# Regarding the Organization of Final Exams for Students with Disabilities.

To ensure the right to education and fair assessment for students with disabilities in accordance with legal regulations and inclusive education policies, Nam Can Tho University hereby announces the organization of final exams for students with disabilities as follows::

#### Article 1: Purpose and Scope:

This regulation aims to ensure the right to education, as well as fair and reasonable assessment for students with disabilities currently studying at Nam Can Tho University.

#### **Article 2: Applicable Subjects:**

Students with legally recognized disability certification (issued by a competent authority). This includes impairments related to vision, hearing, mobility, intellectual ability, speech, or multiple disabilities.

### **Article 3: Forms of Support in Final Course Examinations**

- 1. Extended Exam Time
- Up to an additional 30% of the regular exam duration compared to other students.
  - 2. Reading and Writing Assistance
- May use a scribe or text-to-speech assistive devices.
  - 3. Modified Exam Formats
- Allowed to take oral exams instead of written ones (for students with mobility or visual impairments).
- Provided with large print papers, braille-format exams, or digital formats as needed.
  - 4. Separate Exam Room Arrangement (if necessary).
  - 5. Use of Assistive Software (for online learning assessments).

**Article 4: Support Registration Procedure** 

Students must submit a support request form along with a valid certificate of disability to the University at least 7 days before the exam date. After reviewing the request, the University will arrange a suitable exam format accordingly.

## Article 5: Responsibilities for Implementation

Subject lecturers, faculties, the Academic Affairs Office, and the Office of Political Affairs and Student Management are responsible for coordinating the implementation.
